Data access contract

Contract between The IWDB Work Group (the IWDB) and Academic Institution (the Researcher)

Purpose

The purpose of this Contract is to clarify conditions between IWDB and Researcher after Researcher has applied for access to a specified data set (the Data) for a defined project (the Project). This Contract is a legally binding agreement under Norwegian law between IWDB and Researcher as certified by the undersigning head of department.

Access

IWDB will give Researcher access to the specified Data under the following conditions:

- IWDB will give Researcher access to the Data through a read-only MySQL-interface. Access is given through a server address, database-name, username and password. It is the responsibility of the Researcher to keep this information private and confidential.
- It is the responsibility of the Researcher to make sure Data structure is understood.
- It is the responsibility of the Researcher to create tools for data analysis based on the given interface.
- The Data remains the intellectual property of IWDB and any access is granted on a time limited basis.
- With the limitations stipulated in this Contract, access is given free of charge for use in the Project within the given time frame.

Limitations

- Data may only be used by the Researcher and its team for the Project.
- Access to the Data is limited to the time frame given in the application.
- Extension of time frame will be given for six months at a time if needed to fulfill the Project.
- Data may not be used for any other purpose than given in the application, neither private, commercial nor academical.
- The Researcher may not download a full copy of the Data without prior written permission from IWDB.
- All local - digital or printed - copies of Data shall be destroyed within one year of the Project's closure as estimated in application or extended through application - this does not apply if further Projects are applied for based on the findings of the Project.

Liability

- Data is provided as-is with no guarantee for correctness. Data may be changed by IWDB at any given time.
- IWDB assumes no responsibility for the Data or conclusions drawn from the Data.
- IWDB will do its best to have Data online at all times but no guarantee is given.
- IWDB assumes no responsibility for third party claims made against the Researcher, nor any claims made against IWDB arising from, the Researcher's use of the Data in the Researcher's reports or publications. The Researcher indemnifies IWDB for any such claims.

Attribution

- IWDB is to be attributed in papers based on the Project. Correct attribution is IWDB - The free and open Irish Wolfhound database at iwdb.org.

Publication-rights

- IWDB reserves the right to publish articles in Irish Wolfhound-oriented publications based on published research data, no earlier than six months after publication of original papers. Articles are to be reviewed by researcher prior to publication.

Breach of contract

Breach of contract is punishable under Norwegian law. The researcher understands that any search breach may be taken to court. The researcher agrees that any such case will be brought to Oslo Tingrett in Norway.

Dataset:

The project is granted access to the following dataset:

- a) Pedigree data only (Name, Registration number, Sex, Date Of Birth, Titles, Country Of Origin, Sire, Dam)
- b) Pedigree data and longevity information (a+Date of death and cause of death)
- c) Complete, public IWDB dataset (b+Breeder information, health data)
